



LATE BLOOMING PERENNIALS

Fall gardens can be spectacular with bold combinations of colors, but they do take some planning earlier in the gardening season. Fall bloomers can get very tall and leggy. Once they bloom, they are often top heavy and fall over. To ensure your fall display is as glorious as it should be you will either need to stake your fall bloomers earlier in the season or do some periodic pruning to make the plants stockier and more self-supporting.
