



## XERIC & NATIVE PLANTS

In periodic drought years, when rainfall and snowpack is far below normal, the water available for gardens may be severely limited. Many plants - once established - will thrive with little supplemental water during the dry season. Plants will do best if they are allowed to establish with additional moisture until the root system is developed.
